You are to write between one and two pages (500-700 words) discussing the question of whether Copernicus provided good reasons to believe in a Heliocentric worldview.

First, any good essay will have to describe the meaning of 'Geocentric' and 'Heliocentric'. The natural way to do this is by briefly describing and comparing the Ptolemaic and the Copernican systems. Next, consider why someone (in 1543 – not today) might think that the earth moves or that it doesn't move. Which arguments do you find the most persuasive and why? What about the arguments on the other side? Why are they less persuasive?
