1) Read Harden chapter 12. Explain what she means by a policing being an antieugenic policy. How is this different than simply not being a eugenic policy? How is it different than being genome blind?

2) The genetic information non discrimination act (GINA) prevents the use of genetic information as a basis of differential treatment for health insurance or employment. This is an example of a genome blind policy and so Harden seems to be arguing against it. What is the alternative? What does Harden think would be a good use of genetic information? – Do you agree?
